


The Ministry of Lands announced that all lands offices and registries in the country will remain closed for 30 days.





Metodologia

Este painel foi criado para coletar e divulgar dados sobre o alcance da Covid-19 nas favelas do Rio de Janeiro, devido à insuficiência de testes e dados públicos adequados, na percepção das entidades envolvidas. Se trata de uma pesquisa cidadã, cujas fontes são uma rede confiável de mobilizadores, organizações e comunicadores de favela, além de dados públicos.

Os dados divulgados provêm de duas fontes:

- Os casos **autodeclarados** são registrados através de uma **plataforma de diagnóstico** onde os moradores de favelas avaliam os seus sintomas que em seguida são divididos em três grupos segundo a sua severidade: baixo, médio

Rapid Mapping of Areas Marked for Demolitions and Evictions in Nairobi during COVID-19

Despite the public health risks posed by COVID-19, Kenyan authorities have forcibly evicted more than 8,000 people from informal settlements in Nairobi since May of 2020,

In July of 2020, the Kenyan Ministry of Water and Sanitation announced that the Kenyan Government was gearing up to implement the second phase of land repossession and demolitions in six areas of Nairobi.

Cadasta Foundation partnered with Pamoja Trust to quickly identify, map, and analyze the spatial data of the planned demolition locations to determine the risk level and the number of people who would possibly face evictions.

The analysis found that **+71,000 people** are currently at risk of losing their homes and property.



During a pandemic when social distancing and sanitation are crucial to protecting public health, access to adequate housing is critical to protect people from exposure to the COVID-19 and prevent its spread.

Moreover, these evictions do not meet standards set by Kenyan and international law which requires notice to be written or published in the official government gazette 90 days ahead of time.
